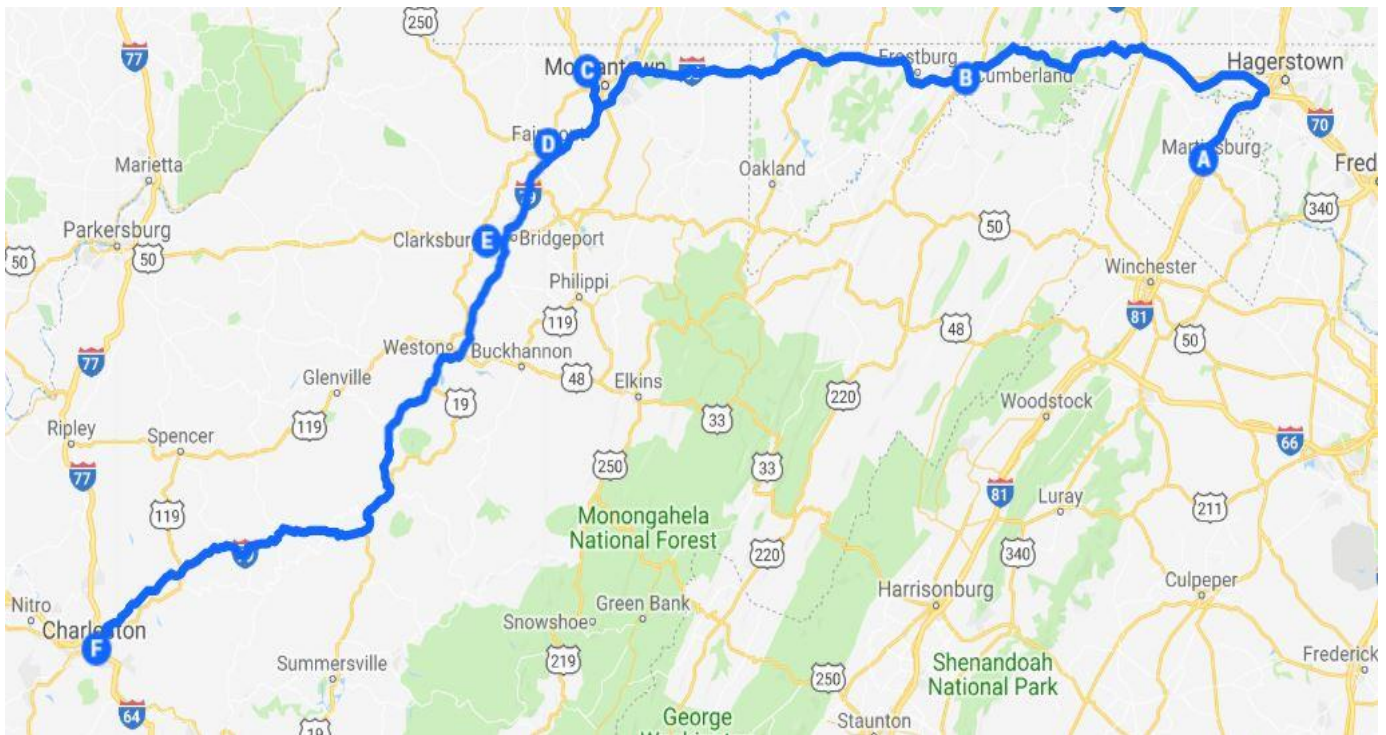


## Route details, Day 2, Monday, November 5:
